



## Questions from Middle School Students

### Do I have to be in Art and Music?

Everyone in grades 5-8 is in art and choir. You can choose whether or not to be in band. Since band meets during school, anyone who is not in band stays in the classroom and has a study hall. All 5th and 6th graders in band are required to take instrumental lessons. Students really enjoy the art and music classes at Freeman Academy.

### Do you talk to God?

Everyone attends chapel on Mondays and Fridays. In chapel we sing, pray and listen to speakers. As one student said, "Speakers always have something fun and interesting to talk about! Chapel is fun!" Each grade also has Bible class or daily devotions. During chapel, Bible class and devotions you will hear the stories of God's people and how Jesus came into the world to be our Savior. You also have the opportunity to share your personal prayer requests with your classmates. All of these experiences help you become a stronger Christian.

### Do you have recess?

Yes! 5th -8th graders have recess built into their lunch period. They also have physical education classes throughout the school year.

### Will I have lots of homework?

Some students have to get used to having homework, but most agree that it is not too much. Older students can expect a bit more but probably not any more than at other schools. Our teachers are always willing to help you if you have questions.

### How long is the school day?

Classes for 5th -8th graders begin at 8:00 and dismiss at 3:00.

### How do kids dress for school?

Freeman Academy does not have uniforms but students are expected to wear clothing that is clean and modest. You may not wear clothes that feature inappropriate messages.

### Is the food good?

Freeman Academy has a great cook who provides home-style meals for the lunches. The salad bar is also available. You will have more than enough food to eat.
