

Gordon and Shirley Brockmueller Scholarship

The Brockmueller Scholarship was created to recognize scholarship, leadership, and to reduce tuition costs. Awards are made each school year and may be presented to one or more students based on evaluation of a written essay by a selection panel including administration and the donors.

Two scholarships of equal value are awarded annually. The amount of each scholarship awarded will be credited against the student's tuition account.

All applicants for a Brockmueller Scholarship must complete a 250-500-word essay on the following question:

How will your studies at Freeman Academy prepare you for a life of service to Christ's church – in your home congregation, local community, pastoral ministry, voluntary service assignments, and/or overseas missions?

Selection Criteria:

- New or current students of Freeman Academy may apply.
- Students who WILL BE in grades 11 or 12 are eligible.
- Demonstrate academic excellence.
- Display an interest in Christian ministry/service.
- Recipients may be eligible to apply and receive a scholarship annually
